


1/ What is word stress?

Word stress is defined as the **<u>prominence</u>** given to certain syllable(s) in a word by the use of greater breath force.

The **prominence** consists of 4 elements



loudness length pitch quality

2/ Levels of stress: 3 levels

=> tonic strong (primary) indicated by (') put before and above the stressed syllable.

=> non-tonic strong (secondary) indicated by (,) put before and under the stressed syllable.

=> unstressed

e.g: communication, population
